The admixed imposters are literate written pieces dating back to the Muromachi period (14th-16th centuries) or even earlier times in the Middle Ages. These would not normally qualify as folktales, i.e. pieces collected from oral tradition among the populace. In a more stringent sense, Japanese folktales refer to orally transmitted folk narrative. Systematic collection of specimens was pioneered by folklorist Kunio Yanagita. Yanagita disliked the word *minwa*, a coined term directly translated from folktale. Yanagita stated that the term was not familiar to actual old folk; he collected folktales from and was not willing to go along with the conventions of other countries.
