He Will Bring Forth Justice 83



There are two important Hebrew words for justice. *Mishpat* is the common and general term, the word used in Isaiah 42:1, 3, and 4. It can be translated "judgment" or "legal principle." It can also denote "propriety" or "uprightness." Another word is *tzedakah*, which implies healthy interpersonal relationships and can be translated "justice," "righteousness," or (in later Hebrew) "ethical conduct."

served, when the handcuffs click on the criminals and the gavel hammers down after a firm declaration of "guilty" from a thoughtful jury.

The kind of justice Isaiah 42 talks about, however, and that Jesus later lived out, assumes that all of us are "bad guys," broken and in need of a savior. We might not have broken our country's laws, but all of us have broken God's laws. We are dependent on God's mercy and compassion, which define God's justice in the world. God's kind of justice isn't merely about punishing crimes; it is also about living out God's mercy and compassion each day.

God's justice is about just-ness. It is about living in accordance with the grace we have personally experienced. Living justly might look strange compared to our modern expectations of justice. God's justice is much more challenging than ensuring we don't break the law or that we're punished if we do. In fact, God's justice may call us to rethink our assumptions about what God requires of us. Instead of simply refraining from harming others, we might find ourselves urged to help them. Instead of minding our own business, we might be encouraged to help other people deal with their business. Our modern sense of justice may tell us to "live and let live," but God's justice tells us to reach out to others. The words of Isaiah 42:1-9 remind us that we are instruments of God's justice here on earth—simply by virtue of being God's servants.

Throughout this session, we need to keep in mind the difference between our modern, Western understanding of justice and a biblical understanding of justice. Put simply, God's justice is at the core of the session, "What would Jesus do?"

Studying
The book of Isaiah can be hugely challenging as well as deeply comforting. The words of Isaiah 42 were written by a prophet who lived with the exiled Israelites in Babylon. As a defeated people forced from their homes in the promised land, these Israelites needed a word of comfort. They needed reassurance that they were still God's beloved people and instruments of God's work in the world. The prophet reminds them in this passage that they are still God's holy people who help bring forth God's justice.
